CONFIRMATION "GUIDE" JOB DESCRIPTION

Overall Purpose:

Youth need to know they are loved and cared for. You are a confirmation "Guide" to care for the needs of those youth in your group using the power of the Word and the Holy Spirit.

Qualifications:

- 4 18 years or high school graduate
- Desire to serve God in many different ways
- Dependable and committed (youth feel abandoned if leaders leave in the middle)
- \rm Flexible

Responsible To:

- The Director of Christian Education or "Head to Heart Director"
- 4 Youth and Families under your care

Responsibilities:

- Time Commitment: (avg 2.5 hours per week)
- Care for up to 6 youth in your midst
- **4** Take small groups away from large group to consider the lessons main points
- Partner in Faith: You will be a partner with you while allowing them to see their own faith journey as fellow disciples. Youth learn by example. You may become their role model.
- Counselor: You will occasionally listen to problems and give advice. The title of counselor should be reserved for trained professionals
- Parent: Although you may have children in confirmation, parenting is not your role in the small group. Treat your child the same as every other child
- Lecturer: Do not lecture, this kills discussion and defeats the purpose of group time
- Flanner: you will make plans and arrangements for the upcoming lessons
- Greeter: you will welcome both members and sometime their friends. This will help teach hospitality. You are not their friend however; you need more authority than a buddy.
- Discussion Leader: Your role is one of listening, discussing and thinking about what has been taught and helping youth draw conclusions from the head to the heart.
- Expert: It is not the guide's role to show expertise but rather to encourage group members to share their knowledge. you are not expected to be a theologian. You may want to invite a pastor to join your group to discuss theological issues.
- 4 Attend Spring Confirmation Retreat as a chaperone for your small group

Time of Contract:

You agree to commit 1 year to this ministry (August - June). If you would like to continue after that please inform DCE or Pastors, and sign another job description

Church Resources: (what will the church need to supply for you?)
