# **CHRISTIAN DOCTRINE**

#### Excerpts from the Large Catechism

God's kingdom comes to us in two ways; first, it comes here, in time, through the Word and faith, and secondly, in eternity, it comes through the final revelation [the return of Christ]. Now, we pray for both of these, that it may come to those who are not yet in ti, and that it may come by daily growth here and in eternal life hereafter to us who have attained it. All this is simply to say: "Dear Father, we pray Thee, give us they Word, that the Gospel may be sincerely preached through the world and that it may be received by faith and may work and live in us. So we pray that they kingdom may prevail among us through the power of the Word and the Holy Spirit, that the devil's kingdom may be overthrown and he may have no right or power over us, until finally the devils' kingdom shall be utterly destroyed and sin, death, and hell exterminated, and that we may live forever in perfect righteousness and blessedness" (427:53-54).

Dear heavenly Father, King of heaven and earth, You have made us part of Your kingdom by the power of the Your Holy Spirit. Give us the power, strength, and courage to live in the world as your children. Strengthen our faith through the study of Your Word.
