


Excerpts from the Large Catechism

This petition has to do with our poor, miserable life. Although we have God's Word and believe, although we obey and submit to his will and are supported by God's gift and blessing, nevertheless we are not without sin (432:86).

Here again there is great need to call upon God and pray, "Dear Father, forgive us our debts." Not that he does not forgive sin even without and before our prayer; and he gave us the Gospel, in which there is nothing but forgiveness, before we prayed or even thought of it. But the point here is for us to recognize and accept this forgiveness. For the flesh in which we daily live is of such a nature that it does not trust and believe God and is constantly aroused by evil desires and devices, so that we sin daily in word and deed, in acts of commission and omission. Thus our conscience becomes restless; it fears God's wrath and displeasure, and so it loses the comfort and confidence of the Gospel. Therefore it is necessary constantly to turn to this petition for the comfort that will restore our conscience (432:88–89).

May God, who gives us all things, including our daily bread, continue to bless us. Amen.


