For Parent's Information:

Indiana State Law says,

If you are younger than 18 years of age when you receive your driver's license, your license is considered probationary. If you have a probationary driver's license, you may drive alone. However, you must observe the following regulations regarding passengers:

- o If there are passengers of any age in your vehicle during the first 180 days that you hold your driver's license, an individual 25 years of age or older with a valid driver's license must be seated in your vehicle's front passenger seat; and
- o If there are passengers in your vehicle, every occupant must wear a seat belt.

If you have a probationary driver's license, you must comply with state and local curfew laws. Drivers under the age of 18 are not permitted to drive after 1 a.m. on Fridays and Saturdays, or after 11 p.m. on Sunday through Thursday, unless the following conditions apply:

- o The probationary driver is accompanied by a parent, guardian or custodian, or an adult designated by a parent, guardian or custodian; or
- o The probationary driver is going to or returning from a job, school, **religious activity**, an activity involving the exercise of civil rights, or an activity sponsored by a governmental or non-profit entity.
